To get to Sanderson Field: From I-5, take Exit 104 towards the Ocean Beaches on SR-8/US-101. Take the Shelton/US-101 exit and drive approximately 17 miles. When you get to the airport, take the second left (Sanderson Way) into the airport. Bear to the right at the "Y" and you will see the entrance gate on the left just past the old runway. Registration opens at 7:00 AM and closes at 8:45. Driver's meeting at 9:00 AM.

Rooms may be available at the Little Creek Casino and Hotel, approximately 4 miles before the airport. Call 1-800-667-7711 for reservations. There is also a Super 8 Motel just 1 mile before the airport. Call them at 1-360-426-1654 for reservations.

Any tire with a UTQG tread wear rating of 140 or less, or any tire marked by the manufacturer as being for “Competition Use Only” will require that the participant be classified in a Prepared Class.

RACE PREPARED:

Any year Corvette with any one of the following:

- A permanently-affixed roll bar or cage of 4 or more attaching points to the frame.
- 25% or more of the stock interior removed.
- Lightened body or frame (do not count bumpers, spare tire, and/or carrier, roof panels, hardtop, soft top, or removable back window).
- Stock windshield removed.

NOVICE CLASS:

This is a class for anyone wishing to try autocross competition for the first time. This is a fun class for new or relatively inexperienced drivers that includes all Corvettes regardless of year or modifications. NWACC Seasonal Championship Points will be awarded to NWACC members.

NWACC Time Only

This class is for participants that have joined NWACC as a Member-At-Large but do not enter a Corvette in the events. NWACC Seasonal Championship Points for “NWACC TO” will be awarded in this class.

TIME ONLY:

This class is for participants who are not a member of either an NWACC Corvette club or not a NWACC Member-At-Large, or for cars other than Corvettes. These entrants **must** enter the Time Only class. No NWACC Seasonal Championship Points will be awarded.
